- Scholastic Book Fair: Thank you for supporting our first Scholastic Book Fair and our All for Books Coin Collection! Because of your help, our All for Books Coin Collection was a huge success! We collected over \$1900 in coins, with Mrs. King's class taking first place with over \$200 just for her class! The money was used to buy books for the teachers' classroom libraries, but it does even more. The All for Books donations help readers beyond our school and community. Scholastic Book Fairs matches monetary donations with a donation of up to \$1 million in books from The Scholastic Possible Fund, which distributes books to children in need through organizations such as Kids In Need Foundation, Reader to Reader, Inc., and the National Center for Families Learning. Your simple act of kindness brought more knowledge, more adventure, more humor, more mystery and more imagination into the lives of young people everywhere! Thank you for your support of All for Books!
 - Also, we wanted to thank all those that volunteered to set up/breakdown the book fair/Family Fun Night, as well as those who volunteered during the Student Shop. With your help, our book fair raised over \$2200! Along with the All for Books Coin Collection, we were able to purchase ALL the books on our teachers' wish lists, buy books for our resource centers and library and will help fund programs that enrich our children's educational experience! We couldn't have done it without you, so Thank You!
- Box Tops: Thank you to all the families who continue to diligently clip and submit Box Tops each month! Box Tops are worth 10 cents each and add up quickly to earn money to support PTA programs. So far this year we have collected 3,872 Box Tops, earning \$387 for our school. This reflects 26% of our fundraising goal of \$1500. Keep on clipping so we can watch those numbers go up and exceed our school year goal in 2017!
 - We're still counting the Box Tops from the November collection; it's not too late to send them in next week! Don't forget to mark your child's name and teacher on your submission so they may receive credit towards our contest. We will have an exciting contest update to announce which classes are in the lead before Winter break! Our next collection will be due January 6th.
