- PTA Meeting: The next PTA meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 10th at 7pm in the media center. <u>Agenda attached</u>.
   Childcare will be provided in the Upper Gym for children in grades K and up.
- Box Tops: Students have been doing an amazing job clipping Box Tops and sending them in! We had collected 1,143 from the summer contest and awarded a student prize in September! Our current contest began in October and we have already received 3,390 Box Tops through December. In total, that's over \$500 earned, which represents 34% of our schoolyear fundraising goal of \$1500.
  - We will award prizes in June, which will include parties for the top 3 classes that bring in the most Box Tops and a gift card for the individual student who clips the most. As of December 31st, Mrs. Pacheco's Kindergarten class is currently in the lead, Mrs. Depalo's second grade class is in 2nd place and Mrs. Wallock's third graders are in 3rd place but this will change as more Box Tops are submitted through June.
  - ➤ We have extended our January submission deadline to Friday January 13th to give you extra time after the holidays to clip and forward as many Box Tops as possible! We will continue to collect monthly through June so there is still time to watch those numbers go up! Remember, only Box Top submissions marked with student name and teacher can be counted towards the contest so please kindly label all submissions accordingly.
